The Torbay Digital Inclusion Network is rooted in communities and collaboration, grown from experience in connecting and working with those groups more likely to be digitally excluded. It will:

- 1. Reach those most vulnerable to digital exclusion.
- 2. Deliver a bespoke 'wrap around' model that supports an individual's long-term digital participation.
- 3. Be a community-led partnership.
- 4. Have a communication strategy that promotes the offer and approach to both individuals and stakeholder organisations.

The website also contains guidance on other areas such online shopping, banking and using SMART Technology. All their e-learning resource pages are open and free to use without the need to register. They also have volunteer Digital 'trainers' who donate their time to helping local people with their digital queries. This could be via regular 'digital drop in sessions' or in some cases even 1-to-1 advice and guidance either over the phone, via email or webchat.
